What to Bring

Please ensure all belongings are labelled with child's name and bring the following to Kindy:

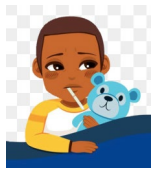
- Hat

We have sunscreen in the classroom, however, please apply sunscreen to child's face, arms and legs before coming to Kindy in the morning.

What to Wear

Please dress your child in clothes that are comfortable and they can move freely in. Your child should be able to climb, jump and run freely. In Kindy we like to have messy play, this includes paints, mud, water and sand. In Summer you may like to dress your child in sandals to make it easy to take off and put back on. We take our shoes off when playing outside in mud and water. In Winter you may like to bring gumboots so your child can enjoy playing outside.



Illness and Allergies

Please keep children home if they are unwell as this may quickly spread onto other children. If your child has an allergy you need to inform the office and classroom teacher.

Informing Staff

Please inform us about matters concerning your child's health and well-being and of changes at home that could affect her/his normal participation in Kindy. Please also notify staff if your child is being dropped off or picked up by someone who is not on your contact list.

Accidents

We will contact you by phone if your child has hurt themselves or is unwell and needs to be sent home.

Birthdays

On your child's birthday we will have a celebration in class. Please feel free to bring in an individual item such as cupcakes or something else to share. This is optional.



SeeSaw

We use an application called SeeSaw to upload your child's Kindy day. Images of your child are only sent to the parents and carers of the child, no one else can access this.
